

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

The Graduate Certificate in Theological Studies is for persons who seek basic theological training to enhance their participation in their congregation or profession. The certificate can also serve as a gateway to formal application to a degree program for those exploring their calling, or, who desire to begin formal theological studies but are not ready to commit to a program of study.

Students must complete the following 18 hours (6 courses) to receive a Graduate Certificate in Theological Studies:
