

# MASTER OF DIVINITY

The Master of Divinity is an academic professional degree which prepares students for a variety of ministries. Students are led to reflect on their Christian experience and call to ministry, to consider the nature of ministry in the Church and world, and to strengthen their lives in preparation for Christian vocation. Students may take three years or more to complete this course of study.

Students must complete the following 81 hours (27 courses) to earn a Master of Divinity with no concentration:
